In 2007, in the central market square in Den Bosch, new lighting columns were installed in RS115 sockets. The columns are removed at least once a year during traditional carnivals to clear the square and facilitate the local fun fairs. Previously this work entailed costly and disruptive excavation and reinstatement of the posts. It is now done quickly and economically. During the carnivals, the lighting columns not in use are moved — without damage to the posts — to spare RS115 sockets at the edge of the square for safe vertical storage.
