Guardrails, signs and traffic signals installed in IPL group's RS socket foundations can be easily removed to give access for wide-load vehicles on tight corners and to create more space for market stalls and crowd movement. When not in use RS sockets are fitted with the plugs provided and are flush to the ground for pedestrian safety. Once the fair is over, all the street furniture is easily reinstated without the need for repeat excavation.
