Glasgow City Council's policy of using RS sockets throughout the city ensures street furniture can be easily maintained and damaged posts quickly replaced without any further excavation. RS140df sockets are regularly used for the installation of wide based illuminated signposts on refuge islands that are liable to damage by passing traffic. Either manually or using lifting equipment, damaged posts are removed in a few minutes and a new post installed immediately minimising the safety risks for workers and disruption to the public.
