RS76 | North Lanarkshire...

All chevron signs in North Lanarkshire are installed in RS sockets which are designed to withstand vehicle impact and preserve foundation integrity. Due to their location on bends and hazard areas, these signs are repeatedly damaged by passing traffic and require regular maintenance and replacement. In 2009, during the refurbishment of a roundabout, the installation of chevron signs in RS76 sockets was hit and the damaged Ø76mm steel posts easily replaced without the need for further excavation
