Kilmainham Gaol is a popular heritage attraction in Dublin and 2015 saw a joint Dublin City Council, Office of Public Works project to improve the public realm and pedestrian facilities in this historic area. The stated aims of the works included street furniture clutter reduction and enhanced visitor and resident experience. IPL group supplied multipurpose Sapa (traffic light & CCTV) columns that can be raised and lowered by means of a seamless integral hinge mechanism. These high specification aluminium columns were installed in IPL group's RS168 sockets.
